This new training program was developed to give those interested in becoming certified grant professionals the foundation necessary to research, write, win and administer grants. The program consists of 40 hours of education and training taught by those who are already Grant Professional Certified (GPC). The training curriculum is endorsed by the Metro-Atlanta Association of Grant Professionals, a chapter of the American Association of Grant Professionals. The 40 hours are spread out over the course of 5 days from June to July.

*As a value added, participants will prepare a draft grant application and submit it to faculty who review and provide comments at the start of the next class.
